The Association on American Indian Affairs in-person NAGPRA Regional Trainings are comprehensive hands-on NAGPRA training that sets the standard for compliant repatriation practice and consultation with Lineal Descendants, Native Nations and Native Hawaiian Organization to fulfill the repatriation requirements of NAGPRA. The training includes plenary lectures, hands-on workshops, small group discussions, practice scenarios, and collaborative coalition building.

All learners will receive a certificate after successfully completing the 3-day training. Native Nation participants will receive a \$100 gift card upon successful completion. Successful completion will require the following:

- Completion of a written pre- and post-assessment to evaluate the class as a whole and for the learner to view their progress;
- On time and full attendance in all NAGPRA Training, and the Intergenerational Healing and Coalition Building courses (collections care and management is optional) - all classes with * are required for the certificate and gift card.
